Amy-Jill Levine was big in Djibouti. When I was there in 2020-21, we offered three of her Bible studies at the base chapel, starting with her Advent study, *Light of the World*. I taught that, and I really wanted to teach her Lent study, *Entering the Passion of Jesus*, but I also wanted to make sure that other chaplains had an opportunity to teach, so a National Guard chaplain, Lee Lockwood, taught that course and another Navy chaplain, Shaun Drefahl, taught Levine's study on the Sermon on the Mount.

I've yet to teach *Entering the Passion of Jesus*, but maybe this is the year. If there's interest, I'd be happy to teach this class in Sunday school during Lent, starting March 2. Since I have reserves the following weekend, I'd resume teaching March 16, and the last class would be on Palm Sunday, April 13.
